Project Overview

As part of the Middle East Water Security Initiative, Zero Mass Water partnered with Mercy Corps, Arizona State University, and USAID to install 27 SOURCE Hydropanels for communities of North Jordan. Completely reliant on low-quality 5 gallon jugs filled at kiosks or hauled from a nearby store, the children and community members needed a solution to provide safe water to drink at their homes. Now, with SOURCE, their water connects to a tap on-site so they no longer have to worry about purchasing water or question if the water they drink is safe.
